


THE FIRST PERSPECTIVE

- The fire escape will be looked at in the spring to get sandblasted and make sure it is structurally safe.
- Mortenson & Rygh made a recommendation for last year's audit. Because most audits cost around \$25,000, most churches form a committee of 3-4 people to review all of the financial paperwork.

- Parsonage Update: All of the kitchen & bathroom cupboards have been installed. The flooring is done on the main floor except the kitchen and living room. The bathroom is completely done except the toilet and sink. The appliances will be the next order of business. The ladies who have been painting are doing a fabulous job and keeping it up with Todd's progress.
- Lenten Schedule: March 8th is Sacred Sounds, which is the service the Stephen-Argyle music students assist with. This service is at St. Stephen's Catholic Church. Trustees:

- Trustees will be starting a log to keep things organized with their projects.
- Leakage and water damage: There has been leakage in along the North wall upstairs. There is also leakage around the bell tower.
- Exterior stone cleaning/treatment: Hebron Brick has a product that will clean the brick. We would have to do the treatment ourselves, but shouldn't be hard.
- Fire escape: Structurally it looks good. There will be a company out of EGF coming to repaint the fire escape the end of May or beginning of June.
- Pat talked to Phil Rogus about seamless gutters. He can't do 6" gutters, which is what we need for our roof size. M&T Gutter from Grafton will be over soon to give us a quote.
- There is a light on the outdoor sign that needs fixing.
- The handicap button is not working on the East door. The trustees will check into getting that working.
- There are bulbs in the front of the church that need to be replaced.
- Yellow lines need to be sprayed to make off the area around the boiler where things cannot be stored.

Parish Education:

- The last day of Wednesday School will be April 19th.
- They are still working on VBS plans with Park River.

Stewardship: As a reminder: We did get the grant to purchase toddler flowers for our musical garden. They will get ordered soon and installed when they arrive.

PASTOR'S REPORT:

- Marilyn will be gone to "Lead by Faith" April 13-15 & May 11-13.
- Marilyn is President of WELCA. April 17th, April 18th & April 27th are WELCA conferences.
- April 23rd Marilyn will be preaching at North Star Manor.
- April 30th is Confirmation-Kristen McGregor, Anders Thompson & Shay Setterholm will be confirmed.
- May 7th is Senior Recognition Sunday-Claire McGlynn & William McGlynn will be honored.
- May 24th is Baccalaureate for the Class of 2023. It will be at St. Rose Catholic Church in Argyle. Marilyn has been asked to speak.
- June 3rd is the Synod Assembly. We don't have many details yet, but it will be offered at 4 locations.

OLD BUSINESS:

Parsonage Update: The committee had to get a new quote because of the addition of the washer & dryer. They are confident that it will still be under the \$5000 approved by the council in January. All of the main floor is basically done. Todd is waiting on appliances. There is an issue with 3 of the cupboard doors. The lumberyard contacted the manufacturer and then want to wait to see if summer, more humid weather will make them straighten out. If not, they will replace the doors on the 3 cupboards. Hopefully Todd will get started on the downstairs soon. He is waiting to see what our spring thaw does around the windows. So far there has been no leakage in the basement! Gannon is checking to see if Dakota TV will take old appliances away. Also, the committee was thinking that our new pastor may want cupboards in the garage, but we would like to ask before installing.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Jane Smidt was at council to express her concerns over the Easter flower issue. There were more names than flowers this year. She is wondering if we could put stakes in the flowers so that the names are more visible as well. We
 will contact Kathy to see if the flowers were ever delivered. Jane was also wondering if the church could order a set
 number of flowers so that we have what we want.
- PCA Graphic display for the organ needed to be updated. It was \$800.00. Betsy made a motion to pay, Brian seconded. All in favor, motion carried.
- Call Committee: The call committee gave an update. They have visited with/interviewed with 3 candidates. We will be updated further at the May council meeting.
- CDs: Pat Heggen, Brian Hendricks, and Betsy Jensen need to be added to the signature cards on our American Federal, United Valley, and KODA CDs. We will update cards each time we elect new trustees and stewardship. Melanie made a motion, Sharon seconded. All is favor, motion carried.

Kris Ann made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Krissy. All in favor, motion carried.
