LENT SERVICE EVENT FOR FIRST LUTHERAN CHURCH WITH FEED MY STARVING CHILDREN



Every year, millions of children die from preventable causes such as pneumonia, diarrhea, malaria and undernutrition. Hunger is still causing nearly half of deaths in children under 5 years old. From this data, we estimate at least 6,200 children die each day from causes related to under-nutrition. This is heartbreaking.

Feed My Starving Children (FMSC) believes hope starts with food. As a Christian nonprofit, FMSC is dedicated to seeing every child whole in body and spirit. FMSC works with food distribution partners that stay with communities

for the long haul, empowering them to move from relief to development.

FMSC meals are developed by food science and nutrition professionals to supplement nutritional needs and reduce problems with malnutrition. Nutrition allows children to grow, thrive and develop to their full potential.

- Parish Education: Wednesday School students will be singing on Ash Wednesday. May 14th has been tentatively set for confirmation. There will be 3 members getting confirmed. Soup & sandwich will be served by the confirmation students before each Lenten service. They will also serve rolls between the 2 Easter services.
- Stewardship: Nothing to report.

OLD BUSINESS:

- Parsonage Update: Todd hasn't been there much this month. The ceiling in the kitchen and dining room is
 fixed and retextured. Can lights have been installed in the kitchen and dining room. The pantry closet is finished. The tub & shower has been installed in the bathroom. He plans to start going up there every day again.
 The 1st thing he will do is get the bathroom subfloor ready to install the toilet and cabinets. Next week he will
 install the kitchen cupboards.
- **Security camera update:** Three of the four are installed. There is a panel in the Secretary's Office where we can view if and only if there is an issue that needs to be investigated.
- Lenten Schedule: Ash Wednesday is Feb 22nd. There will not be soup & sandwich that Wednesday. There will be communion and the Wednesday School students will be singing. This service is at St. Stephen's Catholic Church. March 15th, 22nd, & 29th will be regular services with food at 5:45 and the service at 7:00. April 6th is Maundy Thursday, and April 7th is Good Friday. Both services will be at 7 PM. April 9th is Easter Sunday. There will be 2 services-7:00 & 9:00. Rolls will be served between services.
- The church's custodian and treasurer position were discussed. No changes were made.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Connie & Deanna met with Richard Mortenson about handing over the bill paying and payroll to Mortenson & Rygh. Mortenson/Rygh is to have access to bank statements. Each Sunday the ushers would collect the money. Two of the following people will count the money and sign off: the treasurer, council president, vice president, a member of the stewardship committee or a trustee. The church treasurer will document the information, bring Mortenson the sheet, and deposit the money. The church treasurer would also be in charge of keeping track of each family's yearly giving. The trustees will meet with Richard Mortenson and talk about the details. Kris Ann made a motion to outsource bill paying and payroll to Mortenson & Rygh. Jess seconded it. All in favor, motion carried.
