• Parsonage Update: It's easier to report on what's left! The appliances have been ordered. They will be delivered and installed in the near future. The water issue in the basement is almost done. Again, as a reminder, this summer something will have to be done with the window wells and possibly some fill brought in around the house. Brian was over at the house the other week, and he found an outlet that we will address as soon as LaBine Electric can fit us in. The toilets need to be installed, and the basement is not started yet. The garage is almost cleaned out besides Todd's equipment. The final things will be to get Steamagic to come "bomb the vents", and an intense all over cleaning.

NEW BUSINESS:

- Deanna, Gannon & Connie were here as a representatives of the call committee. They have met with a candidate, Brother Jeff Brown, and the call committee would like to recommend him to our congregation as a minister. Kris Ann made a motion to approve the calling of Brother Jeff Brown as our next minister. Melanie seconded it. All in favor, motion carried. The call committee will do the mandatory background check, which is the next step. According to our constitution, we need to announce a congregational vote 2 weeks prior to the vote. The committee will make announcements May 7th & May 14th. A letter will also be sent out explaining the timeline. The congregational vote will be on May 21st.
- For recording purposes, the following members of the Church Council are authorized to be on the signature cards for institutions where First Lutheran Church has investments: Members of the Board of Trustees-Pat Heggen & Brian Hendricks, and one member of the Stewardship Committee-Betsy Jensen.
- Deanna & Connie have volunteered to go to the Synod Assembly in East Grand Forks.
- Jess made a motion to add Betsy to the St. Petri Cemetery checkbook. Whitney seconded it. All in favor, motion carried.

Krissy made a motion to adjourn the meeting, seconded by Melanie. All in favor, motion carried.

Meeting adjourned with the Lord's Prayer.
