2024 NORTHWESTERN MINNESOTA ELCA SYNOD ASSEMBLY

Jeff Nelson and I attended the 2024 Northwestern Minnesota ELCA Synod Assembly at Concordia College as the voting members from our congregation. This year's theme was Good Soil. This was the first year since covid that an in-person assembly took place. We had a total of 3 plenary sessions. There was one on Friday and the other two were on There was only one resolution that we needed to vote on, Saturday. regarding the compensation guidelines for 2025. The changes were: 1) provide a 3% cost of living adjustments to the base salary charts, 2) add guidance on Minnesota's Safe and Sick law, 3) SAM guidelines have incorporated changes from previous years guidelines that were not reflected in the SAM guidelines going forward, 4) editorial changes to page numbering and table of contents. This resolution did pass. We voted on the Synod budget for the 2026 fiscal year along with the various Synod Elections. The Synod elections for the multiple candidates were: Lay Man, Lay Woman, Person of Color, Rostered Man, Rostered Woman, Young Adult. Otherwise, all other Synod elections had candidates running unopposed. Next year, we will be voting on Bishop. Bishop Tesch has indicated that he plans on running in 2025.

Once again FLC will be collecting the items needed for Lutheran World Relief school kits.


A Thrivent grant will purchase bags and some notebooks. Usually during August there will be sales on these items.
